TRUTH MATTERS

On Matthew 24:9, 10 – Simple and to the Point

Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. (Mt. 24:9, 10; NKJV)

There is a time coming – if we're not already in the early stages! – when global persecution (tribulation and martyrdom) against God's people in Jesus Christ will unfold. Actually, we are clearly seeing various forms of both (tribulation and martyrdom) today.

The English Standard Version translates these two verses in this way:

Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations for my name's sake. And then many will fall away and betray one another and hate one another. (Mt. 24:9, 10; ESV)

Pertinent observations of the text:

- Tribulation and death come to faithful followers of Jesus Christ for My name's sake (vs. 13 calls for enduring faithfulness) – <u>after</u> the period of time called *the time of sorrows/birth pains* begins.
- 2. During this time of tribulation, many will:
- a) be offended / fall awayb) betray one another
- c) hate one another.

The New Living Translation states these verses this way:

Then you will be arrested, persecuted, and killed. You will be hated all over the world because you are my followers. And many will turn away from me and betray and hate each other. (Mt. 24:9, 10; NLT)

In this setting – because the global rapture gathering event does not take place until the *final trumpet* (I Cor. 15:51, 52; Matthew 24:31) – we, His people in Jesus Christ, are called by God to endure to the end.

- We cannot: a)
 - a) fall awayb) betray one anotherc) hate one another

even when the world is plagued with darkness of many forms. (deceit and lawlessness are highlighted in this text)

We must discern the many deceptions since these very things are taking place today. The text below explicitly states great deception, persecution, apostasy, betrayal, hate & lawlessness unfold prior to the sign of the Son of Man (vs. 30) – an event which precedes the rapture gathering of His Church.

So we simply ask: How are we doing in following our Lord's Counsel: "The one who endures to the end will be saved"? "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. But he who endures to the end shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come." (Matthew 24:9-14; NKJV)
