You need to ask God to grace you with the *new birth* which Jesus Christ outlines in John 3. Take time to read this wonderful chapter in the New Testament. Through the shedding of His blood on the cross almost 2,000 years ago, God, as Savior, accomplished salvation for all. What one must do to appropriate this gift is to personally accept Him (Christ Jesus) as one's Savior from sin and eternal death.
