They HATE Us Because We're TRUTH Tellers

When we simply state Truth, why is it, on occasion, some *Christians-by-name* (pseudo Christians) act as if they hate us for it? Is it possibly because they indeed are not really *in Christ*? Sure it's possible!

Sure, the world hates us. Our Lord Jesus said this would be the case. BUT how in the world are "Christians" by name showing distain for our Truth-based appeals? Is the explicit Word of God really their **Authority for faith and practice** or is the incorrect Christian tradition they esteem that which, for them | in their eyes, rules over Scripture? As outlined in the Word of God, events prior to our *Final Trumpet Rapture Gathering* will **include** expressions of hate.

"Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. But he who endures to the end shall be saved." Matthew 24:9-13 (NKJV)

"These things I have spoken to you, that you should not be made to stumble. They will put you out of the synagogues; yes, the time is coming that whoever kills you will think that he offers God service. And these things they will do to you because they have not known the Father nor Me. But these things I have told you, that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you of them. ... These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." John 16:1-3, 33 (NKJV)

The above passages are unfolding today!

"And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ." Rev. 12:17 (NKJV)

Let me cite a specific example ... one that's often a bit more *mild* in expression:

Why does it seem some dogmatic Pre-Tribulationalists *hate* us when we simply state Bible Truth concerning the *bankruptcy* of the Pre-Trib Rapture viewpoint? We have experienced loathing expressions made toward us over the decades. Why? On what grounds would God's true people in Jesus Christ get angry at calls to heed the Word of God? Mark 7 once again comes to mind. As our Lord Jesus contended against the religious traditions of His day, so too do we contend against anti-Bible *Christian pop culture*.

Why does this even matter?

It matters because the biblical theme of *correct readiness* is directly tied to a true end-time perspective. If we have an incorrect view, perhaps we're not watching correctly. Recall: 5 of the watching virgins failed to get into the banquet because they were waiting for the groomsman in erroneous ways. They lacked crucial perspective and resources due to their faulty viewpoint. **May we avoid such disaster!** May we simply be watching in ways that are informed and in submission to God's clear Counsel.
