

# "Endurance" Passages

Do you enjoy a quality compass by which to navigate, one which *speaks* truthfully?

God's Word, the Bible, continues to shine forth as trustworthy and reliable. While there are many awesome, infallible proofs to consider, we especially devote this site toward celebrating His faithfulness concerning the making good of His promises to us in these last days before Jesus Christ's return.

In this context, consider some of the major Counsel on **endurance** He graciously bestows:

Hebrews 10:35-39

"Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward. For you have need of **endurance**, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. For, 'Yet a little while, and the coming one will come and will not delay; but my righteous one shall live by faith, and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him.' But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls."

Hebrews 12:1,2

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with **endurance** the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him **endured** the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."

II Timothy 2:10-13

"Therefore I **endure** everything for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. The saying is trustworthy, for: If we have died with him, we will also live with him; if we **endure**, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he also will deny us; if we are faithless, he remains faithful – for he cannot deny himself."

James 1:12 & 5:11

"Blessed is the man who **remains steadfast** under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him ... Behold, we consider those blessed who remain **steadfast**. You have heard of the **steadfastness** of Job, and you have seen the purpose of the Lord, how the Lord is compassionate and merciful."

Matthew 10:22 & 24:13

“... and you will be hated by all for my name’s sake. But the one who **endures** to the end will be saved ... But the one who **endures** to the end will be saved.” (perhaps some repetition for the sake of emphasis!)

Romans 2:6-8

“He will render to each one according to his works; to those who by **patience in well-doing** seek for glory and honor and immortality, he will give eternal life; but for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury.”

Revelation 2:2,3,29 ; 3:10 ; 12:17 ; 13:10 & 14:12

“I know your works, your toil and your **patient endurance**, and how you cannot bear with those who are evil, but have tested those who call themselves apostles and are not, and found them to be false. I know you are **enduring patiently** and bearing up for my name’s sake, and you have not grown weary ... I know your works, your love and faith and service and **patient endurance** ... Because you have kept my word about **patient endurance**, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth ... Then the dragon became furious with the woman and went off to make war with the rest of her offspring, on those who **hold to** the testimony of Jesus ... If anyone is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes; if anyone is to be slain with the sword, with the sword must he be slain. Here is a call for the **endurance** and faith of the saints. ... Here is a call for the **endurance** of the saints, those who **keep** the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.”

The passages above are taken from the English Standard Version – emphases ours.

God has forewarned us about many challenges that will take place in the days prior to His glorious Son’s return. In this setting, He clearly asks His people to endure to the end. If we maintain His eternal perspective and continue to walk in faithful devotion to Him, we are safe, no matter what darkness befalls. Indeed, God is good to His people in Jesus Christ.

As we conclude this page, here’s an additional word about Endurance Ministries:

It's truly amazing what is happening today! His Word once again demonstrates itself to be trustworthy.
3. Increase in “readiness” as our Lord Jesus has commanded His followers. Time and time again His Word tells us to be **watchful**. In light of His warning that some will depart from the faith in the days of the end, in light of the strong deception characteristic of the end of days, in light of God's requirement that we remain true to Him, we devote ourselves to His eternally significant end-time Truths. We thrive only as we walk or abide obediently in Jesus Christ. This includes patient endurance through it all.
